
For your name to go forward for the executive committee of EFRC, the person must themselves be a paid-up member of the club for the last 2 years

### **Fitness Tests**

For all members who wish to row competitively in 2019 a Fitness test must be done before Fitness/Gym classes start. Fitness progress will be monitored by coaches throughout the year (approximately every 6 weeks). Dates and times will be sent out nearer the time.

#### U16's to Adults

Fitness classes will resume 7<sup>th</sup> January: **U16's to Adults** The Train Station Gym Monday 7<sup>th</sup> January 7.30pm-8.30pm & on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> 8.15pm – 9.15pm cost of these classes will be approx €30per person for 6 weeks **(if doing Monday & Thursday its €60)**

Classes in Aghada Hall will also resume on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> with Carol 7pm-8pm for **12's & 14's** & on Wednesday with Liz for **u14's to Adults** 7pm-8pm (cost of these classes have yet to be confirmed and will depend on class sizes, a text will be sent out once class details are confirmed) payment for all classes have to be made prior to classes to either Ryan/Tena before the 6<sup>th</sup> January.

If not paid you will **not be allowed** to partake in any of the classes

## Please Note:

# U16's to adults if not doing Train Station Gym classes you must do a class in Aghada Hall.

Finally, and most importantly if any member/parent has an issue they wish to discuss with either the committee or selectors they are encouraged to do so, but as is in our club rules, 2 members of either the committee or selectors must be approached at same time. Also while the club phone is used to facilitate the club on sending out info on training etc, it is not to be used as a way of airing a grievance. Issues will only be dealt with face to face.



#### Note to Parents:

While we understand kids / teenagers are involved in other sports, attendance to participation classes, in classes, training on the water and fitness test will be all taken in to account when choosing crews. Selectors are insisting on at least 60% attendance. The selectors will have all this information to hand & will make their decision based on that information
